

ALDINE ISD STANDARIZED DRESS CODE: QUICK REFERENCE 2019-2020

The district's dress code is established to:

- Teach, develop and reinforce and the importance of being "well groomed"
- Prevent disruptions,
- Minimize safety hazards, and
- Assist in providing the safest and secure learning environment for our students and staff.

Student and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the adopted dress code of the district.

In the 2019-2020 school year PK-K, elementary, and middle school campuses will have a district standardized dress code.

Students will be expected to wear a polo style solid color shirt with collar. Must be the appropriate size for student in any of the colors listed below:

- Black
- Burgundy/Maroon
- Dark Green (Forest or Hunter)
- Gold
- Gray
- Light Blue
- Navy
- Purple
- Red
- White
- Yellow
- Pink
- Orange

Students will be expected to wear solid color cotton twill pants, shorts, capris, skirts or shorts. Must be appropriate size for the student in any of the colors listed below:

- Black
- Khaki
- Navy

Jeans and spirit shirts allowed on designated days by the building principal.

Standardized dress for Goodman and Worsham Elementary campuses are as follows:

Students will wear a red polo style shirt with the school's logo and khaki bottoms on Monday through Thursday. Students will be permitted to wear a spirit shirt and jeans each Friday. If students are not in spirit wear, they should be in their regular school uniform.
